

SRV 801 / 811

Safety Relief Valves

The 801 and 811 relief valves are installed downstream of pressure regulators to relieve limited volumes of gas. Used where venting to the atmosphere is acceptable, they provide cost-effective solutions to prevent safety shut-off valves from triggering in case of thermal expansion, transient pressure surges, and creep leaks from regulators. These valves are ideal for low pressure settings due to the increased sensitivity provided by a large diaphragm area.

DESCRIPTION

The 801 and 811 relief valves are spring-loaded throttling relief valves, where a diaphragm measures the system (inlet) pressure, a spring provides the initial load to the diaphragm and establishes the relief set point, and a valve throttles the relief flow.

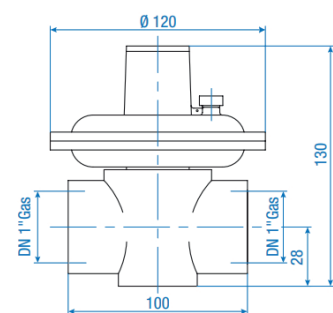

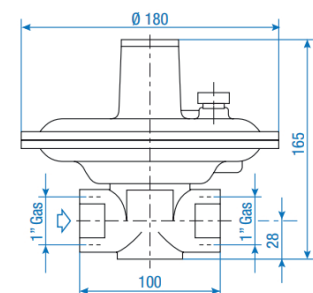

Note: Accuracy at the initial leak point, at which the relief valve begins to discharge, is in the range of $\pm 5\%$ of the setting.

OPTIONS

SRV 811 may be fitted with a pressure tap (Ermeto 8 coupling) for system (inlet) pressure indicator - Code: SRV 811/I or SRV 811/I/TR.

SRV 811 may be fitted with a valve disk down-stream to the flow, which reduces the popping effect and allows a smooth throttling of the flow - Code: SRV 811/A or SRV 811/A/TR.
